Agents

List of people who have collaborated with the Communist authorities in oppressing and denouncing Rumanian citizens:

1. STEFAN Ghita, (now STEFANESCU Gheorghe) former worker in the Ieonida factory (now Atelierele Centrale Auto C.F.R.) in BUCHAREST was promoted general and vice-minister for National Defense for his great devotion to the Soviet cause. He is considered an enthusiastic promoter of the russification of the Rumanian Army which he is leading at the side of BODNARAS Emil.

2. ROHAN Daniel is also a former worker of the abovementioned factory. Having distinguished himself by his brutality and by denunciations against his colleagues, he was called to active service with BUCHAREST secret police. He is now employed in the section of forced labor.

3. VASILESCU Cornel, former electrician of the abovementioned factory is ever ready to denounce fellow-workers for financial gain; he is a man of a violent and bad character.

4. MARIAN (fnu), former worker, now police captain in PITESTI, has caused the arrest of several of his colleagues.

5. VOICILA (fnu), former tailor and an enthusiastic Communist, is at present chief of the "cadres" service in the GAVANA PITESTI tannery. He uses his power for persecuting the workers, and has already sent some people to trial for alleged sabotage, which was only failure in fulfilling excessive norms of work.

6. MIHAI (fnu), a former electrician, director of the BAVANA PITESTI tannery, is a member of the Communist Party. He is disliked and feared by his 300 workers, whom he often forces to do extra work without pay.

Names of peasants who, tempted by prizes offered by the authorities for discovering hide-outs of harvest crops of the "enemies of the people," did not hesitate to denounce their friends and neighbors:

POP Alexandru and GARBAN Ion of RUCASESTI-CLUJ, denounced as saboteurs BANJAN Vasile, BANJAN Ion and BUSTIA Petre.

The Communists TARTAU Petru, DOBREA Vasile and IORDACHE Alecu have caused the arrest of many peasants in the CRETESTI-HUSI village, for agricultural sabotage. One of the arrested, VALEANU Costica, disappeared without leaving a trace.

IBRAIM Omer, a Communist from TUZLA-CONSTANTA, denounced several people for hiding a part of their crops.

CAMPULUNGEANU Constantin and STANCIULESCU Ion, delegates of the collecting center in CALARASI JALOMITZA, caused the arrest of the peasant SMARANDA Stoica from NICOLAE BALCESCU village, for having allegedly supplied poor quality of corn to the state.
