COMMUNIST PARTY, PERSONNEL.

TKACZOW Stanislaw, former Vice-Minister for Agriculture, was recently appointed Vice-Minister at the Ministry for State Properties. TKACZOW, 38 years old and son of a smallholder, was born at the village of BOGUCHWAL, district RZESZOW. For a few years he attended a secondary school but was soon expelled because of complete incapacity and laziness. He had joined the Communist Party at an early date and was ordered to enter an agricultural school at RZESZOW. Three years later he was appointed instructor at the KOLKA ROLNICZE. At the same time he started to spread subversive Communist propaganda among the farmers in the RZESZOW region. Later he was transferred for disciplinary reasons to Eastern Galicia and succeeded in obtaining the position of assistant and later of manager of an experimental agricultural center in district ZALESZCZYKI.

In the years 1939 to 1941 he worked as an agricultural instructor on a kolkoz near KAMIENIEC PODOLSKI, in Soviet Ukraine. After the outbreak of the war he cooperated with the Germans and returned to Lwow, carefully avoiding any partisan activities. After the Soviet victory he followed the Soviet army to RZESZOW.

In 1944 he became a member of the Wojewodzka Commission of the Polish Worker's Party, controlling simultaneously the UB activities at RZESZOW. He organized there the District and Wojewodzki Councils. Some time later the Soviets appointed him Wojewode of RZESZOW. When the so-called National Unity Government was formed he was nominated Minister of Forestry. In the CYRANKIEWICZ cabinet he was Vice-Minister of Agriculture. He was one of the enemies of MIKOLAJCZYK.
