PERSECUTION

Deportees At CAMPUL-LUNG

SOURCE ROME: A foreign citizen expelled from Rumania in 1950.
DATE OF OBSERVATION: 1950.

* * *

The following persons were deported to CAMPUL-LUNG: LAMBRINO Bebe; the NOICA family, a one time well-to-do family; DIAMANDESCU (fnu), an ex-director of the National Bank at TURNU SEVERIN.

All these persons and their families were brought to CAMPUL-LUNG from various provinces of Rumania for the purpose of "forced residence." They are obliged to present themselves at militia headquarters each Thursday between 1700 and 1900 hours, where they have to sign their names, and are not allowed to leave the town. They are living in great misery and have to work on canalization of the tributary of the Targului river (Raul Targului.)

These deportees are supervised by militia Sergeant MITOIU (fnu) who treats them very badly and spies on them to find out what they are talking about.

EVAL. COMMENT: Unconfirmed; the abovementioned names are, however, known to belong to well-to-do families which are likely to have been deported by the actual Communist regime.
