POLISH WRITER REFUSES TO GREET AUTHORESS  
WANDA WASILEWSKA.

SOURCE STOCKHOLM: Confidential source.

DATE OF OBSERVATION: Beginning of April 1956.

EVALUATION COMMENT: The well known source of this report asked that this information be not used in any Radio Program or press articles.

The Polish authoress Maria DABROWSKA was sent to STOCKHOLM at the beginning of April 1956 as a delegate to the extraordinary session of the World Peace Council. The same session was attended by Soviet delegates, among whom was Wanda WASILEWSKA-KORNEICHUK. During the session the Polish delegation met the Soviet one and the delegates had to greet each other. In doing this Maria DABROWSKA greeted everybody except Wanda WASILEWSKA, whom she passed by as if she did not exist.

Asked whether she did not know WASILEWSKA, DABROWSKA gave no reply. Afterwards she said in a private conversation: "I shall not shake hands with this "Moskalica.""
