Radio Bucharest carries an attack on people's capitalism stressing that the number of unemployed in the U.S. is an indication of how well the system works.

The editorial of SCINTZIA today takes issue with the week of captive nations. The main Romanian party daily points out that the Week of Captive Nations is antithetical to the statements by Secretary of State Herter at Geneva that the U.S. is interested in furthering world peace. It is inconsistent, claims SCINTZIA, for the U.S. to attack countries with which it has normal diplomatic relations.
