DATE OF OBSERVATION: August 5 1954.

EVALUATION COMMENT: As the report (following aircraft manifest) does not list first names of the passengers under reference it is difficult to find out their identity. RAKOCZY may be Helena RAKOCZY, Polish woman athlete who takes part in various international sport competitions and PIELA may be identical with the Polish Commercial Attaché at HELSINKI. However, this is just speculation. We are positive in one case: DOMENACH for Jean Marie DOMENACH who was recently awarded a literary prize in WARSAW (see "Dziś i Jutro" of August 1 1954) and apparently was returning to France together with his family.
