

HUNGARIAN COMMUNISTS WILL HAVE CONGRESS IN THE FALL

Vienna, August 15 (Associated Press) - Hungary's ruling "Socialist Workers (Communist) Party" will hold its first convention since the 1956 revolution on Nov. 30, Budapest Radio announced today.

The announcement came amidst speculations about an amnesty for Hungarian political prisoners, withdrawal of Soviet troops and normal relations with the United States as a result of Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev's "peace trip" to Washington next month.

Budapest, August 15 (Associated Press) - Hungary's Communist Party today announced its seventh Congress and first full-scale Party conclave since the 1956 uprising will begin Nov. 30.

The Party, badly shaken by the revolt, held its sixth Congress in February, 1957, in an effort to restore some sort of order in the Party. But it was a restricted affair. The last big Congress was in May, 1954.
