Agerpress has printed slogans for the 15th anniversary of the Romanian People's Republic which included the normal adulation of the USSR as the leading socialist country and in a separate paragraph referred to "friendly relations" between the Romanian People's Republic and the Yugoslavs.

The Romanian delegation to the Vienna Youth Festival passed through the Hungarian border town of Mohacs yesterday and was received by local youth organizations as well as communist functionaries. According to Radio Bucharest, 1,000 people participated in festivities. "...a further manifestation of the eternal friendship between the Romanian and Hungarian People's Republics....Mohacs was decorated with the colors of the Hungarian and Romanian flags." This obvious manifestation of friendly relations might serve to hide some bitterness felt on the part on the Hungarians toward the recent merger of the Hungarian language university and the Romanian language university in Cluj.
