DIESEL ENGINE EXHIBITION IN HELSINKI

An exhibition of Czechoslovak diesel engines was opened at the Engineers House, HELSINKI, on October 22. It is arranged by the "Skoda" works and the firm "GHH," agent for the Czechoslovak export industry organization "Strojexport." The local press describes it as a more or less "symbolic" exhibition. It comprises three types of engines and a series of drawings.

Rudolf BRIZA, a "Skoda" engineer, explained that the main object of the exhibition was to make firm contact with interested circles now in advance of the Czechoslovak Industrial Fair, that will be held in HELSINKI in February 1957.

The main item at the current exhibition seem to be marine diesel engines by "Skoda," made in all sizes from 6 to 2,000 HP.
