ITALIAN REPATRIATES

Another railcar of 32 Italians crossed the Rumanian-Hungarian border at CURTICI on 17 July 1951. Again, the Rumanian wives of Italian citizens were not allowed to follow their husbands.

The repatriation of Italians from Rumania is almost finished. Only a few Italians are remaining in BUCHAREST, beside some traitors, who until now have been successful in saving their property by becoming Communists' spies.

It appears that the arrest of PINTORI (fnu) and Father GATTI (fnu) is due to denunciations by some Italians, who have sold themselves to the Communist regime.

No incidents occurred at the border post CURTICI.
