1. BULGARIA: THE BULGARIAN-YUGOSLAV TALKS IN SOFIA ENDED YESTERDAY, WITH NO INDICATION AVAILABLE YET THAT ANY PROGRESS WAS ACHIEVED ON THE MACEDONIAN PROBLEM OR THAT THE WAY HAS BEEN PREPARED FOR A TITO-ZHIVKOV SUMMIT.

2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: RADIO BUDAPEST YESTERDAY QUOTED MILOS JAKES, CHAIRMAN OF THE CS CP CENTRAL CONTROL AND AUDITING COMMISSION, TO THE EFFECT THAT A CSCP CC PLENUM WILL BE HELD EARLY NEXT MONTH (DS). NO CS MEDIA SOURCES HAVE REPORTED THIS.

3. HUNGARY: NOTHING.

4. POLAND: NOTHING.

5. RUMANIA: GOMULKA'S PRESENCE IN BUCHAREST PRESUMABLY WILL PREVENT CEAUSESCU ATTENDANCE AT DE GUALLE FUNERAL, ALTHOUGH IT IS CONCEIVABLE THAT BOTH OF THEM MIGHT GO.

6. OTHER: BERLIN MAYOR SCHUETZ HAS EFFECTIVELY REJECTED THE "NEUES DEUTSCHLAND" PROPOSAL OF LAST WEEK (CF DR NO 253) THAT THE BERLIN SENATE BE THE NEGOTIATING PARTNER FOR THE GDR ON THE PROBLEM OF BERLIN ACCESS. SEE SCHLEICH SPECIAL -- DS. SCHUETZ STRESSED THAT BERLIN ACCESS MUST REMAIN A TOPIC FOR THE BIG FOUR POWERS AND NOT BE TURNED OVER TO GERMAN AUTHORITIES. HE SAID, HOWEVER, THAT HE WOULD BE AVAILABLE AT ANY TIME FOR DISCUSSIONS WITH EAST BERLIN AUTHORITIES ON ACCESS OF WEST BERLIN CITIZENS TO EAST BERLIN. SCHUETZ ALSO CHARACTERIZED ULBRICHT'S REMARKS CARRIED LAST SUNDAY ON EAST GERMAN RADIO AND TV AS "NOT CONSTRUCTIVE." BOTH SCHUETZ AND CHANCELLOR BRANDT REPEATED YESTERDAY THAT A SATISFACTORY BERLIN ARRANGEMENT IS THE KEY TO RATIFICATION OF THE MOSCOW TREATY AND DETENTE.

THE AMALRIK TRIAL BEGINS TODAY IN SVERDLOVSK AND CAA IS ISSUING A BACKGROUND PAPER ON AMALRIK AND THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF HIS ARREST AND TRIAL.
