Daily since November 1, under the title "Our Native Land", one can hear a new Budapest broadcast, which is transmitted to Hungarians living in West Europe. The requests of Hungarians living in Austria, France, Italy, Germany, Holland, Belgium and England have brought this program into being.

Its purpose is to inform the Hungarians living in Western Europe of the life at home of our problems and achievements.

Some of "Our Native Land's" programs are: talks with persons who have recently returned to Hungary; information about the amnesty decree, the way to come back home and the openings here; one in which relatives living here at home send messages to their relatives abroad. These messages are broadcast free of charge. There is also a great deal of music, on-the-spot broadcasts from theaters, concert halls and other entertainment places. The most outstanding actors will broadcast in verse and prose literary programs. Sundays there will be on-the-spot broadcasts of the most interesting sport events. Answers to letters asking specific questions about affairs in various parts of the country will be given Sundays in the "Our Fathers' Heritage" program. Separate programs will deal with the problems of women and youth.
