GENERAL SUBJECT OF BUDGET BALANCE COVERED IN SEPARATE MESSAGE TO YOU AND MCNEILL. RE ENGINEERING-BALANCES SHOWN IN MUN 49, THESE ALL LOOK REASONABLE. DON'T WORRY ABOUT EXCESS IN U.S. ACCOUNT. WE WILL MAKE FINAL ADJUSTMENTS HERE.

WOULD VERY MUCH LIKE TO RETAIN AUTOMATED TAPE ORDER AND CAN DO SO WITHOUT AFFECTING YOUR BUDGET. UNLESS DRASTIC CHANGE NECESSARY FOR OTHER REASONS, WILL LET STAND.

WE HAVE DISCUSSED CANCELLATION OF THE ORDER FOR ~~251 J.S.~~ *Two Collins 51J receivers*. I ASSUME THESE ARE STILL NEEDED AND YOU DID PLAN TO REPLACE ORDER IMMEDIATELY AFTER JULY ONE. IF SO, CAN HANDLE DIFFERENTLY HERE SO AS TO RETAIN PRIORITY OF DELIVERY.

IF WE SHOULD RUN INTO OVEREXPENDITURE PROBLEM, YOU COULD DEFER DELIVERY OF HUBER RECORDER UNTIL NEXT YEAR AS THIS IS ON SUBMITTED BUDGET.

MOST IMMEDIATE REQUIREMENT IS FOR ACCURATE PREDICTION OF JUNE 30 STATUS AS REQUESTED IN MY OTHER MESSAGE. IF THERE IS SOMETHING THAT DEFINITELY CANNOT BE COMPLETED BEFORE THAT DATE, WE WILL HAVE TO PAY FROM NEXT YEAR'S KITTY AND KNOWLEDGE OF SITUATION NOW WILL PERMIT US TO MAKE BEST USE OF CURRENTLY AVAILABLE FUNDS.
