RUMANIAINDUSTRY

The IPEIL (Industry for the Exploitation and Industrialization of Wood) has its main offices two kilometers north of CURTEA DE ARGES in the beam factory. IPEIL employs some 1,500 to 2,000 workers.

IPEIL disposes of 12 trucks: four ZIS four-ton trucks, four Federal eight-ton trucks, two Blitz three-ton trucks and two Skoda two-ton trucks.

Director of the factory is HERMANN Ion, 40 to 45 years old, Jewish, former laborer. Chief Technician is GERMANEANU Radu, 35 years old. Chief of the Transport Branch is STOENESCU Dimitru, 28 years old. Chief Accountant is NICOLAU Ion, 50 years old. Accountant: MUSTAFA Grigore, 32 years old. Other clerical personnel: TANOESCU Olimpia, 24 years old; VLAGA Elena, 30 years old; PENU Elena (Insurance Branch); VLASCEANU Vetuto, 28 years old and FLORESCU Magda, the last two are typist typists.

Chief of the Supply Branch is MEYER Ion, 55 to 58 years old. POPA Ilie is in charge of the refectory sales shop.

The factory forms part of the "Leon Forestier" Syndicate. The chairman ONICIOIU Alexandru, an illiterate, was replaced by GRECU Ion, a former woodcutter, 32 years old. Secretary of the Syndicate is SIMINEA Ion, 30 years old, a former worker. Chief of Personnel is SAVU Aurel, 47 years old, a former brakesman.

VLASCEANU Ion, a true Communist, was sent to a political Officer's School and returned as a colonel. Other convinced Communists are: HERMANN Ion, FLEAC Ion, STAICU Nisip, SARCAN Petre, 35 to 40 years old; PETRICU Alexandru, 46 years old; foreman of the carpenters' shop, STOICA Ion, 62 years old and REBENTES Anton, 46 years old.

IPEIL produces daily some 16 wagons of fire wood, approximately 60 to 70 square meters of stumps and two wagons of beams, which are exported to Soviet Russia.

Chief of IPEIL Regional Officer is Engineer STANESCU Vasile, a convinced Communist, 52 to 53 years of age.

There are two organizations for the exploitation and industrialization of wood: "Sovromlemn," the mixed Russian-Rumanian Control Board in charge of exports to Russia, and "Comlemn", utilizing minor stocks and scrap wood for the fabrication of furniture and commodities.
