Denunciations

On 17 May 1949 the lawyer IACOBOVICI Gheorghe, residing in DOROHOI, Grigore Chica street 49, was arrested by Securitatea for listening to the BBC, and was in prison for two and half months. In April 1950 he was arrested again at DARABANI, province Dorohoi, together with his friend the lawyer COPRA (fnu). They were denounced as "fascists" by Major COVOR (fnu) of the "Enlistment Center" at DOROHOI.

COVOR was a prisoner of war in USSR and, together with other Rumanian Communist prisoners joined the "Moria-Closca-Crisan Division." He is 49 years old, has chestnut hair, brown eyes and a small moustache; he is a fanatical Communist and a Securitatea spy. His son COVOR Didi, 25, a student, was sent to USSR by the Communist Party in 1949. He is still in USSR. Another son of his, COVOR Sorin, is a second Lieutenant in a Frontier Guard Infantry unit, and is actually serving at the Rumanian-USSR border.

Both lawyers IACOBOVICI Gheorghe and COPRA (fnu) are working as slave laborers on the Danube canal.
