We feel like in prison here behind the iron curtain. The wages are low, while the goods and food are very expensive and there is a shortage of meat too, because everything is being devoured by our cursed friends from the Kremlin.

Dear countrymen, we are waiting for the sun to shine like for salvation, and for you to liberate us from the Bolshebiks because otherwise they will finish us off.

We (illegible) from Poland are waiting for you to chase the red monster away as soon as possible, because we can't move, because there are almost more people in prison than outside. I shall expect an answer over the radio in the "Radio Tea Party".
