LONDON POLISH DAILY OF 25 FEBRUARY 1963 REPORTED THAT 300 POLES, MOSTLY OFFICERS DEPORTED TO USSR DURING WAR WERE RELEASED FROM CAMP NO. 136 AT KARALAMSHA, OMSK OBLAST, LEAVING 27,000 POLES STILL RESIDENT IN OBLAST. POLISH REGIME ISSUE DENIAL IN ITS EXILE PUBLICATION SIEDEM DNI. ON 20 FEBRUARY 1963 POLISH DAILY REPORTED THAT SOME OF THE PRISONERS RELEASED FROM CAMP NO. 136 WERE REMOVED TO A POLISH PRISON AT KORONOWO NORTH OF BYDGOSZCZ, FROM WHENCE THEY WERE GRADUALLY RELEASED. ACCORDING TO THESE PRISONERS, CAMP 136 CONTAINS NOT ONLY POLES BUT ALSO UKRAINIANS, HUNGARIANS, ITALIANS AND GERMANS.
2. ACCORDING TO OUR FILES THE NAME OF ROMAN ZAMBROWSKI HAS DISAPPEARED COMPLETELY FROM THE PRESS AND RADIO SINCE 12 APRIL 1963 AND HAS MADE NO PUBLIC APPEARANCE SINCE THAT TIME. HIS PROLONGED ABSENCE GIVES RISE TO QUESTIONS AS HE IS A PRIMARY TARGET OF THE "PARTISANS".
