

CMEA Agricultural Exhibitions Sub-Committee Meeting

The Agricultural Exhibitions Sub-committee of the Council for Mutual Economic Aid met in Budapest on 22nd July. Delegates from Albania, the GDR, Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Rumania, Czechoslovakia and the USSR took part. The Mongolian and Korean Democratic People's Republics sent observers. The purpose of the meeting is to decide the place, date and character of international agricultural exhibitions to be organised by the member countries of the Council.
