ROMANIA

Radio Bucharest announced that a trade delegation headed by Vice Minister of Trade, Anna Tona, was representing the Romanian People's Republic at the Moscow Fair. The Radio further commented on a trade agreement signed between Poland and Romania. Romania is to export oil, timber, wine, railway equipment, etc. and receive in return machinery, rolled metals, railway material and coal.

The RPR has contracted with India to construct a state oil refinery in Agas. The refinery will have a capacity of 700,000 tons annually.

According to a Reuters dispatch of June 15, a British engineering firm has contracted to build a synthetic tire factory in Romania.
