1. BULGARIA: NOTHING.

2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: NOTHING.

3. HUNGARY: RADIO BUDAPEST BEGAN BROADCASTING THIS MORNING IN ITS FARMERS' PROGRAM EXCERPTS FROM THE DEBATES AT THE JUST CONCLUDED CONGRESS OF AGRICULTURAL CO-OPERATIVES. THESE EXCERPTS ARE FAR MORE EXTENSIVE THAN THOSE GIVEN IN THE PRESS. SOME OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE FLOOR WERE EVIDENTLY QUITE BOLD AND AMOUNT TO A COMPREHENSIVE INDICTMENT OF MANY ASPECTS OF THE REGIME'S RURAL POLICY. AMONG SPECIFIC POINTS CRITICIZED WERE CREDIT POLICY TOWARD THE COOPS, NEW RESTRICTIONS ON INVESTMENTS WHICH MAKE PLANNING DIFFICULT, THE CENTRAL POLICY OF TRYING TO FORCE THE BREEDING OF LIVESTOCK OTHER THAN -- AND AT THE EXPENSE OF -- PIGS, AND MARKETING PRACTICE. THE NEXT HUNGARIAN SIT. REP. WILL WRAP THE MATTER UP.

4. POLAND: NOTHING.

5. RUMANIA: SEE DS ITEM ON THE FOUNDATION OF THE SOCIETY FOR THE CULTIVATION OF CONTACTS WITH RUMANIANS (OF "GOOD WILL") ABROAD. THE FIGURE OF 1,600,000 RUMANIANS ABROAD COULD BE ACCURATE ONLY IF A GENEROUS, ALL-EMBRACING CRITERION IS USED.
