CONTROL ORGANIZATION OF RUMANIAN INSTITUTIONS

The organization of the Sovrompetrol of BUCHAREST is divided as follows: 1) technical division; 2) administration; 3) drilling; 4) production; 5) transportation; 6) refinery division; 7) accounting; 8) planning division; 9) supply division; 10) machine shops; 11) geological research and exploration; 12) laboratories; 13) personnel; 14) finance division; 15) control division.

Each of these divisions has its own control and planning groups. The accounting division controls through its inspectors the finances and the accounts of all division. The planning division controls all divisions with regard to production.

There are further warehouse inspectors, who control the quantity of goods. Each division has its planning service which controls the achievement of production plans, investigates the reasons why plans were not fulfilled, and reports to the division itself. The general manager of the accounting division has absolute control.

The control itself is carried out by organs of the respective Ministry upon which the institution depends. Besides this ministerial control there is a general control by the state control commission, whose president has a ministerial status. This commission controls the entire activity of the societies. The financial and economic control is carried out by the State Bank. This control often infringes upon activities which have nothing to do with finance.

The State Planning Control Commission approves, modifies and controls the planning program of each society.

In exceptional cases of deficiency or irregularity the investigation and control is carried out not only by the above-cited organs, but also by economic militia, the control organ of the Central Committee of the Party, by the directors of the political organization of the society and by the union committee.
