Three issues were raised at the last Geneva conference: European security and German reunification, disarmament and East-West relations. The Western Powers refused even to discuss these questions several years ago. Today they agreed to a discussion, but in each of these three questions they submitted conditions which the Soviet Union was unable to accept.

European security ? - Perhaps, but the reunification of Germany and its inclusion into the Atlantic Pact should come first.

Disarmament ? Perhaps, but a control system (which would have nothing to control) should come first.

Extended trade, cultural etc., East-West relations ? Perhaps, but a free hand for the slanderous and mendacious propaganda of various "FREE EUROPEs" which are spreading nonsense and encouraging sabotage, should come first.
