The Bulgarian Communist Government deports the population of Kuly and Vidin Districts, bordering on Yugoslavia to Dobrudzha, and ~~quart-ring-them~~ in the villages of TSAR SHISMANOVO, SOGDANTSI, NOVA TSERNA and others, from where the Turkish population was expelled to Turkey.

All people able to work are compelled to cultivate the land of the nearby state farm of 4,000 hectares.

The interned population cannot leave the respective districts. For every travel outside the town, a special permit from the local Militia (police authorities) is necessary.
