PERSECUTION

Arrests In BUCHAREST

SOURCE ROME: A person recently repatriated from Rumania
DATE OF OBSERVATION: 1949 to 1950.

Following persons were arrested in BUCHAREST in the above-mentioned period:

DANIELUK Eugen, foreman of the Astra Romana Society warehouses of BUCHAREST and Ukrainian language radio speaker during the last war. Anti-Communist, he was arrested in 1949 together with his cousin, in the Herjenescu ironmonger store of Sf. Gheorghe of BUCHAREST. Nothing is known of what has happened to the two cousins.

Dr. RADULESCU (fnu), 70, ex-director of the Astra Romana Petrol Company of BUCHAREST, was arrested in the autumn of 1950 as anti-Communist. He was a member of the Liberal Party.

PESCARU Lazarica was sentenced to six months imprisonment for selling veal on the blackmarket in 1950.

Engineer ANDONIE George St., ex-general director of the Ministry for Mines and Petrol, was arrested in BUCHAREST in 1949. No news of his fate.

NICULAE (fnu), a driver living on Albinelor street, was arrested in December 1950 for having sheltered an ex-deputy member of the Farmers National Party. He was sent to work at the Danube-Black Sea canal.

EVAL. COMMENT: Unconfirmed. The house of engineer ANDONIE George has still a telephone connection.
