1. BULGARIA: THE BRIEF ANNOUNCEMENT OF JAROSZEWICZ'S ARRIVAL IN VARNA DID NOT INDICATE THE PURPOSE OF THE VISIT. POSSIBLY HE IS VACATIONING IN BULGARIA, AS GIEREK HAS BEEN SINCE EARLY THIS MONTH.
2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: ADVANCE INDICATIONS ARE THAT THE FOURTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INVASION WILL PASS QUIETLY. ALL OF THE EAST EUROPEAN COMMENT SO FAR (BULGARIAN, HUNGARIAN, POLISH) ON THE RECENT TRIALS IS ENTIRELY ALONG THE LINES OF THE PRAVDA EDITORIAL.
3. HUNGARY: NOTHING
4. POLAND: NOTHING
5. RUMANIA: SCANTEIA OF SATURDAY CARRIED A LONG ARTICLE RE-ITERATING THE RUMANIAN STAND ON DISARMAMENT ALONG FIRM ANTI-"SUPERPOWER", ANTI-MILITARY-BLOC LINES. ALSO REPEATED WAS THE CALL FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN TROOPS FROM THE TERRITORY OF OTHER STATES, WHICH COULD BE VIEWED AS BUCHAREST'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK INVASION ANNIVERSARY.
