RUMANIA

COMMUNIST PARTY

The former Secretary General of the Communist Party of Rumania, GEAMANU Grigore has fallen in disgrace, and his arrest by security police might take place any day.

GEAMANU is under suspicion of wishing to escape to freedom. About a year ago, he expected to be sent to STOCKHOLM as Minister Plenipotentiary of Rumania, and hoped never to return. It is rumored that he was betrayed by his wife who was then mistress of GEORGESCU Teohari, Minister of Interior, and is now married to him, having divorced GEAMANU.

There are rumors that political police and the Secret Information Service possess against GEAMANU a complete file of highly compromising documents.

GEAMANU is a lawyer by profession, son of a clerk from the village of TURCINESTI in the GORJ district. He completed his studies in PARIS. He returned to Rumania in 1932, and joined first the Iron Guard, then the Radical Peasant Party of JUNIAN Grigore, ending in the ranks of the illegal organization of Rumanian Communists.
