A Cuban government economic delegation arrived in Bucharest January 2 to negotiate the 1961 Cuban-Rumanian trade exchanges. The delegation, headed by Cuban Deputy Foreign Minister Hector Rodriguez Lompart, was greeted by high officials of the Rumanian Foreign and Trade Ministries among them Ana Toma, Deputy Trade Minister and Vasile Dumitrescu, Deputy Foreign Minister. Heavy press and radio coverage was given the arrival and other radio programs and newspaper articles gave equally extensive coverage to the alleged threat of a U.S. invasion of the Caribbean island -- a coverage far heavier than that given by Rumanian media thus far to the Laos situation.
