Arrests

SOURCE ROME: A telegrapher, about 28, who worked for the State Railwa and an employee of the ex-Concordia factory in PLOESTI (aged about 37.)

DATE OF OBSERVATION: Current period.

DANCU Nicuale, a whole sale dealer, and ATANASE Radu, an employee of the movements section of SINAIA, were arrested in March 1951.

BOZDOC Nicuale, a carpenter, returned from Soviet imprisonment after more than two years, was arrested for sabotage at the beginning of 1951.

DRAGUSIN Constantin, a lieutenant purged from the army, was arrested for political reasons. He originates from SINAIA.

CONSTANTINESCU Constantin, the station-master of PRE-DEAL, was arrested under the accusation of sabotage.

LESETZKY Senislaw, of Polish origin who moved to Rumania when Poland was occupied by the Germans, an employee of the movements section of the PLOESTI station, was arrested for political reasons in January 1951.

GEORGESCU Nicolae, an accountant with the personnel section of the "Concordia" concern was arrested by secret police (Securitatea) during the first months of 1951. It is not known what happened to him.

EVAL. COMMENT: No confirmation available.
