More About "Intrigues" in the Party: On 25th May 'Nepszabadsag' carried a reply to an article which had appeared in 22nd May issue of the paper, in which Pal Gombo had written about "intrigues" in the Party (Summary Part IIB, No.831, p.6). The author of the second article agreed with Gombo that fundamentally honest people who had made mistakes during the counter-revolution should not be subjected to persecution by those who merely wanted to divert attention from their own mistakes. But, he argued, "it is equally our duty to protect communists and non-Party people who have remained faithful to our cause despite being slandered for years".
