

REPRINTS OF THE REPORT.

According to our information, the following reprints or abridged versions of the Report are being issued by Governments or private organizations:

The Austrian Association for the U.N. is issuing a German edition.

The Australian Government has distributed 38,000 copies of Chapters 2 and 17.

The Press Service of the German Federal Government is preparing a full translation to be ready early September. No decision has been taken yet for commercial sale of this edition. However, the German U.N.A. has been approached by an important publishing house.

In Japan the Hungarian Relief Society in Tokyo is preparing a translation.

The Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs is promoting a translation and private organizations will participate in the expenses of printing and distribution.

The United Kingdom Government is publishing an abridged version, containing some 16,000 words.

A number of newspapers have published the Report in serial form; among them the Washington Post, ^Denver Post, Irish Independent and Manila Chronicle.
