IMPORTS VIA TRIESTE TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA -- HUNGARY.

SOURCE TRIESTE : Confidential.

On July 27 1954 the Italian ship "Barletta" of the Adiratica Shipping Company of VENICE, arrived at TRIESTE and unloaded the following:

8 crates and one case of used personal effects, 588 kg.

These were embarked at IZMIR by the Czechoslovakian Legation at ANKARA, and were forwarded from TRIESTE to METRANS of PRAGUE by the local agency SAIMA.

In addition, the same ship unloaded:

146 bales of sheepskins, 15, 300 kg.

These were loaded at IZMIR and are destined for Hungary, being forwarded to SOPRON by the forwarding Branch of the Lloyd Triestino Line.

Lately, the "Barletta" unloaded:

48 bales of rabbitskins, 4,000 kg.

These were loaded at IZMIR and forwarded to METRANS at PRAGUE by the same agency.

On July 27 1954 the Italian ship "Esperia" of the Adiratica Shipping Company of VENICE, arrived at TRIESTE and unloaded the following:

(Over)

2,105 crates of summer-crop lemons, about 80,000 kg.

These were loaded at LATAKIA, Lebanon, and are destined for Czechoslovakia.

This is the first load of summer-crop lemons to be sent to Czechoslovakia since the end of the war. The business was carried through on the basis of the recent commercial agreement between Lebanon and Czechoslovakia. Other loads of lemons are expected from Lebanon shortly.

The lemons arrived in excellent condition and were checked on arrival at TRIESTE by Mr. BEKAR (fnu), the representative of the PRAGUE concern Koospool. The load was forwarded as follows on the same day by the local agent SAIMA:

800 crates for PRAGUE

1,305 crates for NACHOD.
